

IMPORTANT PROGRAMMES AND PROJECTS FOR THE YEAR 2022-23

1. Continuous Swachhata Activities:

69 Universities and 4 Directorates administered the Swachhta Shapath(Pledge). Rallies were organized by the volunteers of Universities/Directorates in Karnataka to spread the message of cleanliness among the people. The Volunteers have worked to keep the campus of Universities and Colleges Clean. The Special importance has been given for this programme in special camp Activities.

2. Republic day Parade Camp

6. Life Skill Education and Counseling

Till Date 136 Training Programmes have been conducted and trained 3826 NSS Programme Officers and said programme officers have counseled 7,52,642 volunteers/ Students. In 2023-24 Rs.70.00 Lakhs have been released for implementation of the programme.

7. Implementation of NSS to the Students of Higher & Primary School.

A number of NSS programs and activities have been implemented to students in a simple manner to touch the mind. Awareness Programme will be conducted about the discipline and values of ideals. For Implementation of the NSS at High Schools Grant of Rs.80.00Lakhs has been released.

8. Yuvajanotsava under NSS

To organize Yuvajanotsava, under State Govt. Grants released Rs.4.00 Lakhs each to University of Mysore, Mysore, K.L.E. University, Belgaum, Davangere University, Davangere and Sri Krishna Devaraya University, Bellary in total Rs.16.00 Lakhs has been released.
